

## **Marina Notice – 2023**

### **Special Notice Regarding the Marina Boat Storage Racks:**

***Plans for cleanup and redesign of the Marina Storage Racks for Kayaks and Canoes are underway. Please Remove all Boats from the marina storage racks no later than September 30, 2023.***

***Any Boats (Kayaks and Canoes) left in the area will be removed and disposed of after September 30 2023.***

***If for any reason you cannot meet this deadline, please contact the Marina Committee immediately to make arrangements.***

All Boats, Canoes, Kayaks and Paddle Boats (boats) must be registered in LAE and must display the LAE decal. If no LAE decal is on the boat, it will be removed and disposed of.

The LAE Registration decals are distributed by LAE volunteers. Please contact Bob Wright – bobthebuilder@gsinet.net for obtaining a decal.

Any Boat (including Canoes, Kayaks and Paddleboats) once registered can be stored on the wooden racks at the Marina. This is based on a first come first serve basis as rack space permits. If there is no rack space available, please take your boat home with you when you are finished boating for the day. Boats cannot be left on the grass area.

The grass area at the Marina must remain clear of all boats for lawn maintenance and for allowing access for emergency vehicles to get to the helicopter landing area at the end of the peninsula.

Boats left on the ground are subject to being moved to another location by the Marina Committee or the Board of Directors.
